The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity, as this relates to the meaning for each individual within it.

Introduction

The Relationship Report for two individuals applies to any type of relationship. It focuses on the relationship itself, rather than on the individuals who make it up. First a composite chart (mid-point chart) is created. The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together in relationship. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity.

In the following report, each planetary placement and aspect is examined to reveal the basic qualities of your relationship, with the most important factors described first. Please keep in mind that these descriptions are not meant to put limitations on the relationship, but merely to describe its inherent tendencies. Challenging aspects can become the greatest strength of a relationship if you can both learn how to successfully navigate those issues, with good communication between you playing a vital role. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

Chart Patterns

Grand Trine

You have a Grand Trine in your chart. When three or more of your planets form a Grand Trine with each other, you will have an exceptional area of talent represented by the element in the trine, either Fire, Earth, Air or Water (usually these planets are in just one element). You will display a marked self-sufficiency and also will have good success in your endeavors in this area of life. You must also beware, however, of being lazy or complacent.

Yod, focal planet Mars

You have a Yod planetary aspect pattern in your chart, also known as the 'finger of God'. This pattern consists of two different planets forming inconjunct aspects of 150 degrees to a third, or focal, point. Usually there will be a marked emphasis on the area of life represented by this focal point, which may be one planet, or two or more in conjunction. You may have physical or psychological problems associated with the expression of the energies of the focal planet or planets, creating a subtle form of tension in your life. The key is adjustment. Your lesson is to transform the expression of these energies along more positive lines.

The placement of Mars in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared activity in pursuit of partnership goals, and where ego needs may be identified.

Mars in the Second House (or sign) brings out a persistent and patient drive in your relationship and gives it an endurance that may outlast many others. Your shared energy may not burst from the gate and it may take one or the other of you working individually to get things started, but once you do get things going, they will tend to keep going. Since money and security are important shared concerns this is a good placement for business partnerships. Taken to an extreme, your relationship can also bring out inflexibility in each of you or possessive attitudes. In romantic relationships, you may go out of your way to experience sensual pleasures and luxury. If there are challenging aspects to Mars, you could find that you need to work through a tendency for acquisitiveness, or resentment toward each other. As a partnership you are likely to have an artistic flair and you function well in the realm of the material and tangible world. You benefit when you cultivate an attitude of sharing and a more relaxed approach toward money matters.

Composite Mars in Cancer (or the fourth house) brings out a sensitive, sensuous and emotional drive between you. You have a strong mutual energy for creating a shared environment, or possibly for real estate investment together, but it might be hard to see your partner's point of view. You have a family-like concern for each other, but may not have the best sense of where to put your energy to create a mutual advantage or it may be difficult to get clear on priorities. In a romantic connection, family will be important, and the work of home-making. You will also likely spend a lot of your shared energy within the safety and privacy of your own

space. You can appear timid with each other, but you both are actually quite strong and may be surprisingly determined when you act from an instinctual level rather than from your conscious will. Tension can arise between you if security needs are not being met, or if you disagree over family matters or turf issues. Your relationship benefits when you consciously find common ground and find ways to regularly let off steam. You also benefit from relaxing more and from diverting your inwardly turned energies outwardly toward the world around you.

Important Features

Composite Uranus in Aquarius (5° Aqu 52'R) Composite Uranus in the Ninth House

Uranus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter unusual and unexpected circumstances and where the relationship benefits from lack of structure.

Uranus in the Ninth House (or sign) brings to your relationship an original and inventive cast of mind, with strong intuitive powers. There is likely to be an inherent love of philosophy and higher learning. With this placement you two tend to share strong religious, or religious-like beliefs, although perhaps expressed in an unconventional manner. In a romantic relationship you have a harmonious higher mind connection with each other and will always have plenty to discuss. You are likely to enjoy the exploration of new horizons together, either mentally or through travel, and you might need to be ready to jump into the car at a moment's notice. You share a powerful sense of optimism and a tendency for reckless behavior at times, since together you may not always look before you leap, and you benefit from exercising caution when it is appropriate to do so. As a partnership you possess high ideals, and share a capacity to visualize new possibilities rather than accept an outmoded status quo. You may have come together in part in order to support each other through this very process. At your best, you have the faith to bring forth, in leaps and bounds, a new vision for yourself and society at large.

Composite Uranus in Aquarius (or the eleventh house) brings an eclectic and forward-looking orientation to your shared goals and group affiliations. This is a natural placement for Uranus and brings out the most positive manifestation of this uniquely oriented energy, and your relationship is likely to be idealistic and unconventional. As a partnership, you tend to associate yourselves with friends and groups having as their goal the betterment of society. In a romantic connection, you have a solid basis of friendship, and you can spend a lot of time together without stagnating. Your relationship has high entertainment value and long standing durability based on the excitement of shared ideas. Your challenge may be to find an equally close emotional connection with each other. Because this is the most changeable of planetary energies, your relationship goals and group affiliations will constantly migrate into new patterns. You may also experience some ups and downs with group participation under stress, although you have a tendency to bounce back from any downside fairly quickly. Together you have a strong urge for personal

freedom, and love to explore new horizons together. Your highest mission is to make available to others, through collective action, the progressive ideals for social reform that you cultivate as a partnership.

Composite Sun in Leo (15° Leo 09' 01")

Composite Sun in the Third House

Ruler of sun sign - Sun's ruler

The placement of the composite Sun defines the core identity of your relationship, and the place where it finds its greatest vitality. It gives you a sense of the predominant flavor of the relationship.

The composite Sun in the Third House indicates a relationship that settles in very comfortably and finds its home in the day-to-day. You coexist easily and can support each other's priorities. The timing of things often synchs up between you, creating a joyful spontaneity. In romantic relationship, in spite the abundance of harmony and ease found in your connection with each other, or maybe because of it, there can be a tendency for boredom to arise. When this happens, you can draw upon other facets of your lives together to provide the stimulation you need to keep things between the two of you out on the growing edge. In a business partnership, this placement is favorable, since the third House rules commerce and trade. With Gemini as the sign associated with the Third House and Mercury your ruling planet, it is also likely there is a special emphasis on communication between you. At the very least, your conversations will tend to cover a wide variety of topics and they may rise to the level of a transcendent art form. Your mutual focus on getting your point across may lead to a joint writing venture or other form of verbal communication with the world outside your partnership.

With Composite Sun in Leo, this relationship centers on its abundance of fun-loving, expansive, and creative energy. Unless there are challenging aspects elsewhere in the chart, yours is likely the sunniest relationship in the whole zodiac. You two exude a sun-like warmth between you and around you. Regardless of your individual temperaments, this relationship tends to bring out dramatic, creative, and assertive energies in both of you. You may find that there is a natural spark between you as well as a high degree of shared courage and honesty, and that when you are together you radiate self-confidence. In a romantic relationship, the creative spark between you indicates a high degree of romance and affection as well as sexual attraction. You may need to take time out to rest every once in a while. You also may find that your relationship dynamics quite naturally become the center of attention of a larger group. Together, you can be quite determined and have a knack for manifesting the things that you want. Composite Mercury in Leo (3° Leo 18')
Composite Mercury in the Third House
Ruler of Rising Sign

Mercury in the composite chart reveals the quality of the communication process in your relationship, and an area of your shared experience where intellectual compatibility is to be found.

The composite Mercury in the Third House indicates a relationship with easy communication between you and great energy and enthusiasm for discussion. You are a particular kind of idea mates with a healthy understanding of what makes sense to the other person, and tend to talk at great length with each other on all kinds of subject matter. As a partnership you are very curious and do not confine your investigations and explorations of the world around you to any one area, preferring the butterfly approach, lightly skimming the flowers and grasses of information and circumstance. In a romantic context, the congeniality and relaxed imparting of ideas that you participate in can be a great blessing, for you will always be able to talk about what ever might be bothering either one of you. You may find that you are more excited by your mental connection than your physical or emotional one, although this may be balanced by the other factors that you share. In the absence of a good emotional connection between you there could be difficulties since thinking will only take you so far in intimate connection. Composite Saturn in Libra (24° Lib 37')
Composite Saturn in the Fifth House

Saturn in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter limitations and build long-lasting success through trials of accomplishment.

Saturn in the Fifth House (or sign) indicates a blockage in the self-expression in your relationship. There may seem to be a barrier between you and your partner when it comes to your capacity creatively express yourselves, or there may be a sense that

the relationship lacks sufficient love and acknowledgement of each partner's contribution. In a romantic relationship, there is a feeling of heaviness between you that is hard to shake. You have come together for some very specific purpose, and it does not seem to be the joy of sharing yourselves with each other, or the laughter of new connection. If you have children, or plan to, this will become an important focus. There may be difficulties involved, but also a strong bond developed over the issues of either children or creative productions. Jupiter in the Fourth House (or sign) magnifies the loving, kind and caring qualities within your relationship. Your connection with each other is likely to be friendly and sociable, generous and high-minded. You two have an instinct for nurturing others as well as yourselves, and find enjoyment, opportunity and growth in this type of tribal sharing. Together you may possess excellent executive abilities. You share an inherent spirituality, which is displayed not in philosophy, but in acts of love and kindness. You work well in partnership with the public, and attract material rewards without seeming to try for them. In a romantic relationship, you share a natural sense of security, and enjoy each other's family and your own if you have one together. Composite Jupiter in Leo (or the fifth house) magnifies the generosity and vitality within your relationship and brings out your love of pleasure. You two like to show off your good side, and have a natural flair and sense of showmanship that carries you far in life. You make an excellent entertaining team. In a romantic relationship, it pays to remain as aware as you can of the effects of egotism on the part of each of you. You may struggle competitively unless you realize the greater power of a more transpersonal approach. You enjoy the limelight as a couple, and do well when you shine out and share your wealth with those around you. As a partnership, you can be extravagant at times. You benefit when you learn to keep track of your resources and to build a strong foundation under your dreams, as these practices are essential to your success. Together, you have a great sense of intuition, and make capable leaders. Your true leadership in social circles may come when you begin to trust your inner guidelines and look outward to see what you can give rather than what you can get.

Composite Moon in Aries (0° Ari 17' 40") **Composite Moon in the Eleventh House**

The placement of the composite Moon defines the core emotional focus of your relationship. It indicates the most sensitive area between you.

The composite Moon in the Eleventh House symbolizes a relationship with a natural level of love and trust between you and strong ideals. You work well as a team, with an emphasis on shared values. Your vision of your future is likely to agree on nearly all points with your partner's, and you respond to each other with a high degree of unselfishness. The very nature of this partnership is accepting and undemanding. In a romantic relationship, you are generally very loyal and willing to oblige your partner's needs with intrinsic liking for each other. There can be a sense of idealization surrounding the mutual connection that you have with each other, with an easy ability to find intrinsic value in each other, which is great for maintaining a friendship in the midst of romance although you may tend to show up in a less affectionate and more impersonal way for each other. As a partnership you may find yourselves involved at the very center of your circle of friends or groups that you favor. You give yourselves easily to the group effort, and may need to pull back at times from over-involvement.

The composite Moon in Aries indicates a relationship that provides a strong and solid base for a wide range of emotional expression between you. You two tend to have an ardent feeling nature with inclinations toward quick bursts of passion, expressing your independence and impulsiveness. tend to jointly react to situations with action rather than reflection. In a romantic relationship, you enjoy a shared capacity for fun and fireworks, although your passion may be variable. Allow the passion to come when it comes, and go when it goes; you can trust it will eventually return again, as enthusiastically as ever. In this relationship, you may find you can hold space for each other so you can each share pent up feelings from experiences in the outside world. Composite Neptune in Capricorn (28° Cap 13'R) **Composite Neptune in the Ninth House**

Neptune in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter idealization and nebulous spiritual feelings that will lead you to self-discovery.

Neptune in the Ninth House (or sign) brings an impressionable, idealistic and highly intuitive quality to your relationship. As a partnership, you two are likely to be inclined to the mystical, and high minded, perhaps seeing life in terms of the poetic rather than the practical. You have a natural bent for philosophical discourse or perhaps teaching together, but you may need to guard against over-idealization. You are likely to share a belief in the unknown, and to have a great desire to explore, travel and experiment with new ways of doing things. In close interpersonal relationship, you can always enjoy the extra romantic edge that comes along with your shared adventuring. Together you may have an urge to get away from it all on a regular basis, and may be attracted to spiritual studies, or psychedelics and the like to achieve transcendent states. You benefit when you are careful not to get too carried away with your ideas, and when you find ways to ground your flights of fancy into concrete realities.

Composite Neptune in Capricorn (or the tenth house) brings an idealistic nature to the way that you jointly interact with the world. You may achieve much together in helping others. On the other hand, you may also experience some degree of confusion regarding this relationship or your role within it. You benefit when you make an extra effort to understand what you are trying to accomplish together and stay on top of your responsibilities to each other and with the world around you. In a romantic context, this relationship has some very high ideals, and perhaps illusions, associated with your joint interaction. You each have an idealistic streak that carries over into the way you see yourselves in relationship with each other, while others may not be able to understand what's going in your relationship at all. Composite Pluto in Sagittarius (2° Sag 30') **Composite Pluto in the Sixth House**

Pluto in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter your mutual drive for power and which will be transformative for the relationship.

Pluto in the Sixth House (or sign) correlates to a relationship where there is a need to sacrifice to the other and to the relationship. As a partnership, you may also experience a strong desire or even a compulsion to be of service to the general good or to others that you encounter. You may find you are working through very deep-seated unconscious dynamics of being truly helpful and available to others. In a romantic relationship, in order to prevent power struggles that inevitably play out within the issues of sharing and service to each other, it is important that you carefully turn the light of consciousness onto the working dynamics of the relationship. In spite perhaps of a culture that does not encourage it, you benefit when you develop an ability to mutually acknowledge the power dynamics at play, and to begin to cultivate a very real and sincere humility, or take the time to access built-up and unresolved emotions within you, and just let it be. Composite Chiron in Aries (18° Ari 32')

Composite Chiron in the Eleventh House

Chiron in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter patterns of wounds and deep connection and where eventual healing and empathy will occur.

Chiron in the Eleventh House (or sign) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding your vital force around belonging to a group consciousness and integrating with the human family. In this relationship, you find yourself vulnerable to losing your personal identity to a group cause or belief system. You may find yourself attracted to membership in groups or social organizations and then have painful realizations while in the midst of the crowd. It may be that membership in a group or "in-crowd" was denied you in your youth. It may be that your partner reflects the influence of a parental-like authority figure who forced you in a particular direction that you had no real calling for. You may have had to make the tough decision between abandoning your parental guidepost or your own true self. In time you can heal these wounds as you create a partnership and other friendships that reflect your actual ideals rather than consensus reality. Though it takes time to develop deep self understanding, it may be one of the most worthwhile of undertakings, especially if you want to become truly self-determined and independent of the strictures of society. You may find you are truly called to become an exemplar of a particular group ideal that is just breaking into the awareness of the world at large. You may be called to go where no (wo)man has gone before. Though it may take many trials and tribulations before you both begin to realize the extent of your true potential, the gold at the end of this particular rainbow is worth the effort.

Composite Chiron in Aries (or the First House) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for the two of you to face and heal deeply held wounds with regard to your vital force to be and to initiate within the relationship. With this placement of Chiron, your very sense of the relationship may be threatened by disturbing realizations and painful memories. Together, you may work through pain that arose from feeling belittled and put down, rather than encouraged, by the significant adult figures around you in your formative years. Within this relationship you may encounter and overcome obstacles that prevent yourselves from reaching your full potential. You may find that in this relationship, you operate more from a fear of failing than from the expectation of success that would breed confidence for further achievement. You may find yourselves sacrificing your own goals to the goals of the other, or to those around you, because they seem somehow more important or at least deserving of priority treatment. Either one of you may feel a keen lack of achievement in your own life, and compensate by trying too hard to help others, putting yourself in the background. As long as these relationship patterns operate more or less unconsciously, they are difficult to overcome, so the first step in surmounting them is to become more conscious of what's going on inside. Become aware of your own pain. Acknowledge and discover more about what exactly went on in past relationships to make you both feel so resigned with your present abilities in this one. At that point you can begin to come out from behind your painful

experiences and really show yourselves to each other and to the world around you. With a more conscious understanding of your own dynamics, you can begin to help others in how they deal with similar issues, transforming your false sense of vicarious achievement into a strong center of true friendship.

Composite Venus in Cancer (6° Can 49') **Composite Venus in the Second House**

The placement of Venus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared emotional focus and love and where mutual enjoyment and benefit lies.

Venus in the Second House (or sign) indicates that there is a solid basis of good will and financial stability between you. Your relationship thrives on shared values and a mutual appreciation of art and beautiful surroundings. If you have a communal space of any kind it is likely to be elegantly furnished. In a romantic relationship, this placement symbolizes a strong need for commitment and for creating a pleasurable life style together. Your love is earthy, grounded and long lasting. It is very likely that you will own your own home or property at some point in time, should you remain together. You like to entertain and show off your possessions and your living space. Just be careful not to let your appreciation of the finer things of life distract you from the internal beauty of the love you feel between you. As a partnership, you do well in investment or real estate. You value material things and excel in the appraisal and exchange of these things, and indeed with your finances generally. You have your feet very much on the ground in these matters. You also value art for art's sake, and will always be able to take an abiding sense of enjoyment from music and the arts.

With composite Venus in Cancer (or the fourth house) there is a solid basis of security and stability between you. You fundamentally trust each other, and that is a great blessing for any type of partnership. In a romantic relationship, this placement symbolizes a deeply felt connection between you regarding values and aesthetics and the roots of your being, psychological or environmental, as in home and family. You are fond of children and the life of the home. You are likely to be gentle, receptive and charming with each other, and you undoubtedly have an aesthetically pleasing home. Together you make a very devoted and loyal couple, sharing your sensitive and caring nature with others. As a partnership, you may be able to earn money based on your living space, either working there or being advisors for decor and interior design. You value kindness and trust between people, and naturally create a calm and beneficial environment as you work and share together.

Sun, Moon, Rising Sign Features

Gemini Rising

The composite Rising Sign is the image that this partnership presents to others and characterizes the nature of the relationship.

With Gemini rising in your composite chart, your relationship tends to be airy, intellectual, and full of commentary about life and other people. You mutually engage in wit and humor, and bring these qualities out in each other when you are together. Gemini is the sign associated with thought processes, communication and the conscious mind. Your ruling planet is Mercury. Your relationship may be characterized by the experience of two sides of things, and since you exhibit a great deal of curiosity about life in general, you may find that together you engage in many varied types of experience. You enjoy sharing conversation with each other. In a romantic relationship your love of conversation brings you great pleasure, either in or out of bed. Composite Mars in inconjunct (fading, 0.7 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

This aspect between composite Mars and Uranus brings to your relationship a powerful eccentricity with an original and eclectic mindset and a keen intuition. You two are strong-willed and nonconformist to the point of resisting each other as well as outer authority and occasionally display fits of temper. You may feel restless in this relationship or lack steadiness as you pursue your joint goals. If you keep your eyes open, really try to learn what makes your partner tick, and accept what you see, you can make the most of unconventional attitudes and bold behavior. Change and variety excite you as a partnership, and your urge for constant breakthrough may frustrate or confuse those around you. You share at your essence a courageous and pioneering spirit that gives your relationship a sense of mission around bringing new ideas into being. You benefit from bringing consciousness and clarity to the expression of your joint goals.

Composite Mars in inconjunct (fading, 4.1 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

With this aspect between composite Mars and Pluto, your relationship has a passionate intensity and also the potential for conflict. There is a powerful connection between you based around the concept of self-assertion, either yours or your partner's, and one reason that you have come together at this time is to attempt to heal this issue in your lives. In a romantic connection, your sexual magnetism and activity is likely to be strong, as well as issues of power and control that are likely to crop up between you. The pattern of your relationship may be such that one of you appears timid or unsure to the other partner much of the time, since the power urge when problematic commonly hides deep underground, but there is the potential for sudden bursts of anger when repressed emotion finally finds its way to the surface. As a partnership you are inclined to the mystical, seeing life in visionary and poetic terms rather than in the practical. Composite Jupiter in inconjunct (fading, 3.2 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Composite Saturn in bi-septile (fading, 1.6 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies darkly interact; incline to occult dimensions apart from socially accepted norms.

This aspect brings an impractical, eccentric and future-oriented quality to your relationship. You two may find you rebel against authority, and with your strong

imagination and good conceptual level, you probably have good reason to want to do things in new and different ways. When you function at your best you have the capability to bring a concrete and real-world practicality to the intangible and visionary Uranian energy. You benefit when you learn to move away from a knee-jerk reaction either for or against established authority, toward establishing your own personal authority, in your own way, and to help make your brilliant visionary impulses concrete and available to society at large.

Composite Saturn in square (forming, 3.6 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect can bring clear thinking, discrimination and grounded action to what otherwise might be a very nebulous relationship. You two tend to be responsible, compassionate and take social issues very seriously. You may participate in an active way with music or the healing arts. With these two planets in challenging aspect, however, you may find that the limitations of Saturn combined with the confusion of Neptune leaves you both feeling depressed about the general state of things from time to time. Composite Saturn in bi-quintile (forming, 1.6 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Composite Uranus in sextile (forming, 3.4 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This combination in your composite chart serves as a divining rod in your relationship, connecting your relationship to the forces at work on a collective scale. It indicates that you are tuned in to the energy of the larger whole, with a special focus on its ultimate evolution and transformation. **Composite Uranus in quintile
(forming, 0.7 degrees) with Chiron**

One or both of you may have an unusual combination of personality traits in which you are very unconventional yet also somewhat unsure of yourself in your very departure from the rest of society, so that you may surprisingly show flashes of a conservative side. **Composite Uranus in semi-square
(fading, 0.7 degrees) with North Node**

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; calmness is required.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

**Composite Neptune in septile
(forming, 0.6 degrees) with North Node**

The planetary energies darkly interact; incline to occult dimensions apart from socially accepted norms.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

**Composite Pluto in sesquiquadrate
(fading, 1.0 degrees) with Chiron**

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; control is required.

With this aspect in your composite chart you are likely to be engaged in a relationship in which there is difficulty and also great healing potential around issues of power and control. There may also be compulsive behavior on the part of one or both partners that comes up for greater acceptance and eventual healing during the course of this relationship. As a result of your life experiences before coming together, one or both of you may exhibit signs of a compulsive desire nature. Potent healing abilities are ultimately indicated with this placement, but you must first work through some tough issues, and this relationship can be life changing in that regard. **Composite Chiron in semi-sextile
(forming, 1.7 degrees) with North Node**

**Composite Sun in weak conjunction
(forming, 11.9 degrees) with Mercury**

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This placement gives your relationship strong communication skills. There may be a shared delight in mental pursuits. You two naturally understand each other's heads and hearts, and often know what the other person is saying even before they have finished saying it.

**Composite Sun in weak conjunction
(forming, 8.2 degrees) with Jupiter**

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

With this conjunction between composite Sun and Jupiter, your relationship has an optimistic and expansive quality that steadily whispers possibility. If together you believe it can happen, it often does. As a partnership you are likely to be spiritually motivated, offering warmth and generosity to each other and to those around you. You also may share executive abilities. In working as a team, honors and material success are likely to accompany you. You benefit when you remember to pace yourselves, and keep in mind the limitations of your actual physical situation. Together you are attracted to higher learning, the fine arts and travel. The house involved with this placement may well indicate the arena of life that will become the most successful part of your partnership together.

**Composite Sun in weak opposition
(fading, 9.3 degrees) with Uranus**

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect between composite Sun and Uranus, your relationship has an eccentric and uniquely idealistic quality. Together you two can be determined to live your own unique vision of life, and love freedom from conventionality. Your relationship has a tendency to experience some instability, and you may periodically create situations, or circumstances may arise from outside, where the relationship crashes and burns, and then begins again from a new foundation. Issues with commitment and responsibility may also arise. You have the capacity to support each other in inventing new approaches and developing original thinking. This way you help each other to push the envelope of conventionality, and perhaps at times stretching beyond the breaking point. In a romantic context, you may also have a propensity to give each other little jolts just where you know it will evoke the biggest buzz, creating tension that keeps things exciting, and can also be occasionally irritating. Composite Sun in weak opposition (forming, 9.5 degrees) with Midheaven

With this aspect between composite Sun and the Midheaven, your relationship has a concentrated focus on intention and a powerful achievement orientation. In a romantic relationship, an active orientation to joint projects that you wish to undertake. You may however differ over the goals of the partnership, and must have the ability to compromise and to provide support each other in your individual career objectives. A drawback is that your relationship may be more susceptible to matters of prestige and other outside influence than you would like. Composite Moon in weak square (forming, 6.5 degrees) with Venus

Together, you emanate social charm and attractiveness, and your loving disposition brings grace to any room you inhabit. Though you two tend to treat each other with kindness, you may sometimes find that underneath it, an irritating grain of sand has gotten inside your shell. Simple things between you two can somehow get complex. You may find you are reluctant to talk about this irritation that you feel, for fear of complicating things further still. Composite Moon in weak conjunction (fading, 10.1 degrees) with North Node

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Composite Mercury in weak opposition (fading, 5.1 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Mercury and Neptune indicates a clever and imaginative relationship but one with the potential for miscommunication and deceptive illusion between you. You are bound to connect very deeply with each other on subtle, psychic and unconscious levels, and you also are bound to run into some confusion while doing it. You communicate in a very sensitive and attuned way, with a capacity to feel each other, literally, across time and space. However, when it comes to practical interchanges, you may find that the ideas you mutually generate get only half-baked, or that they come out of the oven with several key ingredients missing. You might have been sure that you got your point across, for example, only to find out later that it was grossly misinterpreted. In a romantic relationship with this placement, you do well to develop alternative modes of communicating. When making joint decisions, you could try tuning into your hearts or your guts rather than your heads, relying on what you feel and know, rather than on what you think at the time. It benefits you to share your secrets, developing a regular practice of revealing more and omitting less, and to experience the vulnerability and joy that comes from breaking through limiting fantasies or the appearance of aloof detachment. Composite Jupiter in weak trine (fading, 4.8 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

With this aspect in your composite chart you are likely to be engaged in a relationship that has a strong connection with its own unique brand of spirituality. One or both of you may have been wounded in your inherited beliefs in some way; perhaps in your early life you may have been forced into relationship with some sort of spiritual community to which you did not feel a deep bond. If so, this issue remains to haunt you to a greater or lesser extent in your adult life, and it is likely that this relationship will have a positive affect on the situation. Through conversations and activities with your partner, you may well feel your way into a different and more fulfilling connection with the divine, as manifesting in each of your hearts and minds, although not necessarily from the standpoint of any other societal group. Together you have an abiding interest in matters of religion and philosophy, although this is likely to represent your own style of spiritual involvement rather than any form of spiritual institution.

Composite Saturn in weak opposition (fading, 6.1 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect in your composite chart you are likely to be engaged in a relationship in which there is difficulty and also great healing potential around issues of authority. It may be that one or both of you have had painful experiences as a child, when you were forced to submit to an arbitrary authority or limitation of some kind. Perhaps you had the experience of a bad father. The relationship with your father was damaged in some way; it was something you had to get away from, either from his overbearing nature or from his neediness and lack of presence. These wounds can manifest in adult life as an attachment and also great difficulty with authority. For example you may endlessly achieve positions of authority and then have second thoughts about it. As you continually work through whatever arises in your daily interactions with each other, these types of issues may come up for acceptance and eventual healing. Since the powerful associated emotions may lie below the level of your ordinary awareness, your relationship connection may help to bring them to consciousness, and eventually acceptance. Composite Uranus in weak conjunction (fading, 7.7 degrees) with Neptune

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

With this aspect between composite Uranus and Neptune, your relationship tends to be future oriented and idealistic with a strong awareness of collective energies. You likely share with your partner an interest in mysticism and the occult. Social ideals will powerfully affect your relationship's expression in the world and your shared concept of spirituality. You may feel a joint pull to use the relationship in the service of humanity. The two of you have a high awareness of collective energies and you may feel a strong pull to be of service. As you put your social ideals to the test and learn from the mistakes of the past, you can provide a gift not only to yourselves but to the larger world around you as well.

Composite Pluto in weak square (fading, 7.8 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Pluto and the Midheaven brings to your relationship a passionate intensity and also a great potential for personal evolution. There is a depth to your connection with each other that may not seem obvious on the surface, but which over time you find is there. Deep needs are triggered in each of you, and one or both of you will perhaps profoundly change as a result of your coming together. In a romantic connection, the possibility is there for conflicts over who has the authority at any given moment. The sexual arena is one place that these control issues may manifest. In any case, there is unconscious energy to be discovered and discharged as a result of your joint enterprise, and a profound sense of your mission together, which may go through many changes on the way to discovering what that mutual purpose truly is.

Glossary

Ascendant: The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.

Aspects: When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within

a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the aspects used in this report is given below.

Conjunction — $0^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Square — $90^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Opposition — $180^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Sextile — $60^{\circ} \pm 6$ degrees

Trine — $120^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Inconjunct — $150^{\circ} \pm 4$ degrees

Chart Comparison: An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the inter-aspects between the two charts to be examined.

Composite Chart: An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.

Horoscope: Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in "your monthly horoscope."

Midheaven: The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.

Natal: From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart, or planetary positions at birth.

Nodes: The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.

Planets: In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.

Transits: Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
